

Mayor Aaron called the regular meeting of the Humble City Council to order with a quorum present at 6:30 P.M.

1. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Council Member Funderburk offered the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. SPECIAL PRESENTATION BY HUMBLE RODEO AND BBQ COOK-OFF COMMITTEE.

Members of the Humble and Atascocita FFA introduced themselves and informed the Council of their collective activities and accomplishments, which were in part a result of the funds raised by the Humble Rodeo and BBQ Cook-Off and also invited the Council to attend not only the Rodeo but also the Livestock show as well. The FFA members then presented the Council with business card holders.

Mr. Brodie Wagner, Chairman of the Humble Rodeo and BBQ Cook-Off Committee addressed the Council telling them of the growth of the Rodeo over the years and informed them of the grants that are made possible by proceeds from the Humble Rodeo and distributed to numerous programs throughout the Humble Independent School District through the Humble ISD Education Foundation. Mr. Wagner also noted the partnership between the City, the Humble Civic Center and the Rodeo and stated he hopes it will continue into the future.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk, the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed to approve the Consent Agenda.

4. ORDINANCE 16-771 AMENDING CITY OF HUMBLE ORDINANCE 14-742, PASSED AND APPROVED THE 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2014 AND BEING AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF HUMBLE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015, BY ADDING TO THE BUDGET ADOPTED HEREBY AN ADDENDUM NO. 2; PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN AMENDMENT TO SUCH BUDGET; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT.

City Manager Boeske asked for approval of the budget amendment.

Upon a motion by Council Steagall, the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed to approve Ordinance 16-771 adopting the Budget Amendment.

5. ORDINANCE 16-772 ENCUMBERING FUNDS BUDGETED IN FISCAL YEAR 2015 FOR SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT, PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS, DECORATIONS, TRAINING, UNIFORMS AND BADGES, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS AND COMMUNITY SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED DURING FISCAL YEAR 2016.

City Manager Boeske asked for approval of the encumbered funds ordinance.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk, the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed to approve Ordinance 16-772 approving the encumbrance of funds from FY 2015 into FY 2016.

6. ORDINANCE 16-774 AMENDING CITY OF HUMBLE ORDINANCE 14-747 BY AMENDING CHAPTER 8 AMUSEMENTS AND ENTERTAINMENT, ARTICLE V. REGULATION OF GAME ROOMS AND AMUSEMENT REDEMPTION MACHINES, SECTION 204 RESTRICTIONS, REGULATIONS, CONTROLS AND LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT MATTER.

City Manager Boeske stated that the distance was being changed from 1000' to 300' and provisions for proximity to day cares, public parks, and residential areas was being removed to align the ordinance with state and case law.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk, the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) to approve Ordinance 16-774 adopting amendments to the regulation of game rooms and amusement redemption machines ordinance.

7. APPROVAL OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAT FOR MR. EXPRESS AT WILL CLAYTON, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF 1.9699 ACRES OF LAND, LOCATED IN THE WHERRY B. ADAMS SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 95, CITY OF HUMBLE, HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS; 1 RESERVE, 1 BLOCK.

City Manager Boeske stated that the plat met all of the City's specifications.

Council Member Pierce asked what the developers' plans were for landscaping the area. Todd Blitzer, the architect for the project stated that there would be landscaping in the area which would include shrubs and plants along the perimeter of the parking area so as to buffer the parked cars as well as trees at the endcaps of the parking aisles.

Council Member Pierce asked if this would be a gas station. Anil Mohammed, who is the developer of the property stated it would be a gas station and convenience store. Council Member Pierce stated that he hoped anything they (the developer) could do to make the corner look attractive would be appreciated as it is a major gateway for the city. Mr. Mohammed stated that he realized how important the corner was for the City, especially considering the City's welcome sign is located just off their property and it being an entrance into Bush Intercontinental Airport.

Upon a motion by Council Member Steagall, the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed to approve the Mr. Express at Will Clayton Development Plat.

8. APPROVAL OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAT FOR AIR 59 COMMERCE CENTER, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF 28.0286 ACRES OR LAND SITUATED IN THE WHERRY B. ADAMS SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 95, CITY OF HUMBLE, HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS; 2 BLOCKS, 2 RESERVES.

City Manager Boeske stated that the plat met the city's specifications and that this was for the tract of land which was the balance of acreage located at the corner of Will Clayton and 59. City Secretary Stuebe added that the reason for this being submitted as a development plat was so the developer of this property along with the developer of Mr. Express could submit their plans for a private drive which would straddle the property lines of the two tracts.

Council Member Pierce asked about the purpose of the detention area shown in the plat. City Secretary Stuebe stated that it was to serve as regional detention for the 28 acres as well as the Mr. Express location.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk the City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed to approve the Air 59 Commerce Center Development Plat.

There being no further business before the City Council, Mayor Aaron adjourned the Regular Meeting of the City Council at 6:58 P.M. on Thursday, January 28, 2016.



“How Much Government is Enough?”

Last Wednesday, the Senate Select Committee on Property Tax Reform and Relief held a public hearing in San Antonio. The committee heard testimony from several witnesses who perceive problems with the property tax system in Texas. That testimony, unsurprisingly, included the recommendation to impose revenue caps on cities.

Several witnesses, including city officials and business groups, voiced their opposition to revenue caps. One member of the committee, Senator Van Taylor (R – Plano), asked multiple witnesses who expressed concern with revenue caps an important question: “How much government is enough?” Though the question appeared to imply that those against revenue caps supported increasing the size of government, the question (and its answer) actually highlights the reason why revenue caps are such a bad idea.

“How much government is enough?” is a question that each city council discusses every year when setting a city budget. The answer is discussed in multiple meetings over the course of month, sometimes longer. It’s discussed in city council meetings, budget workshops, and public hearings on the budget and tax rate, not to mention local restaurants and grocery stores. City councilmembers are elected because they are trusted to be able to listen to their constituents and put in the hard work and long hours to make sure the city government is run in a way the reflects the needs of the community.

Is an eight minute police, fire, or emergency response time considered to be too much government? Does a city have too much government if it repairs all of its major streets? Or is maintaining local parks for city residents “too much?” City officials, with input from their citizens, answer these questions based upon any number of city-specific factors.

Revenue caps are an attempt to undermine the relationship between city officials and their constituents. They are a declaration that city officials lack the capacity to adequately determine the level of taxation within their city. In reality, city officials are in the best possible position – much better than a state officeholder – to gather all the relevant information and make informed decisions regarding the size and role of their level of government.

The Committee’s San Antonio hearing was one of six that are planned in different locations across the state. The Committee will hold the second of its on-location meetings at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Regional Academic Health Center in Harlingen on Thursday, February 11, 2016. The League’s Message on Property Tax Reform “Road Show:” Revenue Cap is a Diversion from Legislative Failings

The following is an op-ed by TML President-Elect Mary Dennis, mayor of the City of Live Oak. It was published in the January 26, 2016, edition of the San Antonio Express-News, the day of the first Select Committee hearing.

When politicians fail to perform their duties in a responsible manner, do they typically publicly admit their failing or look for someone else to blame? Unfortunately, the blame game is the more likely response.

And that is one reason for creation of a Texas Senate committee on property taxes that is bringing its road show to San Antonio this week: to blame cities and counties for high property taxes and divert attention from the Legislature’s failure to adequately meet the needs of one of the fastest-growing states in the nation.

The Senate leadership has already made it clear they once again will try to pass a law in the next legislative session to restrict local control over city and county budget decisions by imposing revenue caps that limit the ability of locally elected officials across Texas to fund the services their voters want.

Texans pay some of the highest property taxes in the nation, but city property taxes are not the cause. Texas cities — and there are more than a thousand cities in the state — only collect about 16 percent of the property taxes paid each year in Texas. The most recent figures from the state comptroller show that about 55 percent of property taxes go to school districts and school district tax collections increased at twice the rate of city property tax collections.

The reason for high school-property taxes is the state's failure to fund its share of the cost of education. It is a well-known fact among those versed in the state's Robin Hood school finance system that legislators depend on rising property valuations and higher local property taxes to shrink the amount of state revenue they must budget for schools.

If legislators want to make a meaningful reduction in property taxes, there is a very simple solution: Increase the state's share of funding public education and reduce its reliance on local property taxes.

Currently, if a Texas city increases property tax collections by more than 8 percent over the previous year, voters can petition for an election to rollback the increase. Bills have been introduced in past legislative sessions to replace that 8 percent "rollback rate" with a revenue cap requiring an election to approve any increase over 4 percent — all with the false claim that this would provide property tax relief.

The truth is that taxpayers in most cities would see no reduction in their city property taxes from revenue caps while the average homeowner in some cities might get a reduction in their city taxes of \$20 or \$30 for the year.

In the city of Live Oak, where I have the honor of serving as mayor, this year we were able to reduce our property tax rate from \$0.51 per \$100 of valuation to \$0.467691, a reduction of more than 8 percent.

Had a 4 percent revenue cap been in effect over the past decade, the city of San Antonio would have lost more than \$250 million in revenue needed to provide necessary services to its growing community. But the average homeowner in San Antonio would have seen a reduction in city taxes of only \$44 per year - or \$3.67 per month.

State officials should stop trying to fool Texans into believing that imposing revenue caps on cities would give meaningful tax relief because city taxes are not the problem.

State officials have no responsibility for providing vital city services like police and fire protection, trash collection, sewage treatment, street maintenance and many others. And, unlike many other states, Texas' state government provides no funding to help cities pay for those services.

Furthermore, the state often tries to shift some of its fiscal responsibilities to the local level. In much the same way that the state has forced school districts to pay a greater share of the cost of education, it has also demanded that cities and counties pick up an increasing share of the cost for building state highways.

As long as our state relies on local governments to meet the needs of our rapidly growing population, the state should continue allowing locally elected officials the flexibility to determine their own budgets. Local officials are closer than state officials to the taxpayers who will hold them accountable for tax rate increases.

State officials should stop trying to hide their own failings behind this smokescreen of blaming local governments for high property taxes. Cities are not the problem, and revenue caps are not a real solution.

Licensed Carry Confusion Continues

The Senate State Affairs Committee met last Tuesday to discuss the following interim charge:

Monitor the implementation of open and campus carry legislation and determine if the current laws regulating the places that handguns can be carried are easily understood or if clarification is needed to ensure the average citizen understands when, where, and under what circumstances it is lawful to carry a weapon, versus when it is a criminal offense for which there may be a defense.

The Committee heard invited testimony from university chancellors, prosecutors, open carry advocates, and groups asking for the sensible regulation of guns. Of particular interest to cities, the confusion surrounding licensed carry in and around courts was discussed, including possible ideas for legislative clarification next session. Wireless Towers in the Rights-of-Way?

Your city could soon see a forest of wireless antenna poles and towers in its rights-of-way if two wireless telecommunications infrastructure companies have their way at the Texas Public Utility Commission (PUC). And the companies want to install the poles and towers to support their systems on the public property for free.

Last October, a wireless tower builder known as Extenet filed a complaint against the City of Houston at the PUC. The complaint asks the PUC to order the city to allow the company to install equipment for a “small” antenna, as part of a distributed antenna system (DAS), in the city’s rights-of-way on their own poles or existing utility poles. A similar complaint was filed in December against the City of Dallas by a company known as Crown Castle.

The legal aspects of the case are complex, but the underlying premise is not. The case is about wireless antenna poles and towers being installed in the rights-of-way by a private company wanting to profit from the free use of taxpayer-owned property.

The companies claim that a 16-year-old law, Chapter 283 of the Texas Local Government Code, gives them the power to move forward with their plans. Chapter 283 has never been applied to allow wireless equipment installation in the rights-of-way. Moreover, these same companies have previously installed wireless facilities in the rights-of-way only after obtaining a city’s consent.

Chapter 283 significantly altered the procedures under which cities collect compensation from local wireline telecommunications providers that use city rights-of-way. Chapter 283 replaced telecommunications franchise agreements with a new system of compensation based on retail, end-user “access lines” for the formerly city franchised wireline providers. Essentially, a PUC certified telecommunications provider (CTP) may use the rights-of-way and pays compensation for the use of the ROWs based on how many retail end-user lines it operates in a city, known as

“access lines.” The new access line system represented a relatively successful compromise in 1999 in the context of a rapidly changing, and recently deregulated telecommunications industry.

Extenet is arguing that, because it is a CTP, its use of the rights-of-way is governed by Chapter 283, including installation of wireless equipment. However, because Extenet has no retail end-use customers, it has no access lines, and thus pays no access line fees under Chapter 283 for that installation.

If your city has not been approached by these or similar companies, it may soon be. City consent has always been required before any company can use any public property, including use of the public rights-of-way, for private use (e.g., water tower leases for antenna). That authority could be lost if Extenet is successful at the PUC. Every Texas city could be affected by the outcome of the complaint. The League, likely in conjunction with the Texas Cities Coalition for Utilities Issues, will be filing comments in the PUC proceeding.

In addition to the state-level threats discussed above, federal legislation with a similar goal has been introduced. The federal Mobile Now Act, which is pending in the U.S. Senate’s Commerce, Science & Transportation Committee, would preempt local authority over the siting of wireless equipment and set limits on compensation paid for putting that equipment in public rights-of-way. The U.S. Conference of Mayors has prepared a [letter in opposition](#) to the bill that allows mayors to sign on electronically.

TCEQ Accidental Discharge Rules

Last month, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) commissioners approved the publication of proposed rules implementing Senate Bill 912, which was passed during the 84th Legislature. The bill relates to volume-based exemptions from reporting requirements for certain accidental discharges or spills from wastewater treatment facilities or collections systems.

The proposed rules allow any single, accidental discharge or spill of treated or untreated domestic wastewater that occurs at a wastewater treatment or collection system owned or operated by a local government to be reported to the TCEQ monthly, as a summary of spills, provided the following conditions are met:

1. the spill volume is 1,000 gallons or less;
2. it is not associated with another accidental discharge or spill;
3. it is controlled or removed before entering water in the state;
4. it does not adversely affect a public or private source of drinking water;
5. it will not endanger human health or safety or the environment; and
6. it is not otherwise subject to local regulatory control and reporting requirements.

Additionally, the proposed rules require the owner or operator of the facility or collection system to use one of three standard methods in the proposed rule when calculating the volume of a discharge or spill. The proposed rules will also require the TCEQ to consider the compliance

history of the individual and to establish procedures for formatting and submission of the monthly summary. Because the proposed rules essentially track the language in S.B. 912, the League will not file comments.

The [proposed rules](#) are scheduled to be published in the Texas Register today, which opens the [public comment](#) period. Comments are due by March 7, 2016. The TCEQ will hold a public hearing on March 1, 2016, in Austin at the TCEQ headquarters located at 12100 Park 25 Circle, Building E, Room 201S, at 2:00 p.m.

ORDINANCE NO. 16-775

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A GENERAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 7, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 3, A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 4, A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 5; AND A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, CERTAIN PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE EXISTING CHARTER OF THE CITY; STATING THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BE VOTED UPON AT SAID ELECTION; ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS AND POLLING PLACES FOR THIS ELECTION; AND MAKING PROVISIONS FOR CONDUCTING THE ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE TEXAS:

SECTION 1. A general election and special election is ordered to be held by the City of Humble (the "City") at the polling place and election precinct within the corporate limits of the City, as hereinafter designated, on May 7, 2016 from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. At this election, the qualified voters of the City will elect a City Council Member for place three, A City Council Member for place four, a City Council Member for place five, with each position having a term of two (2) years; there shall be submitted to the resident qualified voters of said City, for their action thereon, propositions for certain proposed amendments to the existing Charter of the City of Humble, Texas. Such proposed amendments are as follows:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 1

Article II, Section 7 of the Charter of the City of Humble, Texas, shall hereafter provide as follows:

"Section 7. – Meetings and compensation of mayor and council members.

The City Council shall hold at least one regular monthly meeting and the mayor or three council members may call as many special meetings as may be necessary to attend to the municipal business. The mayor and council members may receive such pay and compensation, including necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties, as may be prescribed and set by City Council by ordinance."

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2

Article VIII, Section 5 of the Charter of the City of Humble, Texas, shall hereafter provide as follows:

"Section 5. – Personal interest.

All elected or appointed members of the city council or of any city board or commission shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 171, Local Government Code, regarding conflict of interest and, by affidavit filed with the

city secretary, shall disclose the nature and extent of any substantial interest in any business entity or in any real property, as defined and required by that chapter, which would be affected by any official action taken by the body of which such person is a member and shall abstain from any participation or vote on any such matter.”

SECTION 2. Should any candidate in the general election fail to receive a majority vote, then in that event a runoff election shall be ordered for every place in the general election to which no one was elected as required by Article II. Section 2 of the City Charter. In the event it becomes necessary to conduct a runoff election the runoff election and canvass of returns shall be conducted in accordance with Section 2.025 of the Election Code.

SECTION 3. The entire corporate limits of the City shall constitute one election precinct and the polling place for said election shall be City Hall located at 114 West Higgins, Humble, Texas.

SECTION 4. Early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail. The period for early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be April 25 through May 3, 2016. Optical scan ballots shall be used for early voting by mail. The Early Voting Clerk for said elections shall be the City Secretary or his designee. He shall determine the number of election workers to be hired and arrange for training of all election workers. Early voting by personal appearance for the general and special election shall be conducted City Hall, 114 W. Higgins, Humble, Texas

April 25 – April 29 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
Monday – Friday

May 2 – May 3 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
Monday – Tuesday.

SECTION 5. Early voting by mail ballot shall be conducted in accordance with applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code. The address of 114 W. Higgins Street, Humble, Texas 77044, shall be the early voting clerk’s mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent for the City.

SECTION 6. All early votes and other votes to be processed in accordance with early voting procedures pursuant to the Texas Election Code shall be delivered to the Early Voting Ballot Board of the City of Humble. Early votes shall be counted at City Hall. The Early Voting Ballot Board shall perform in accordance with applicable provisions of the Election Code.

SECTION 7. A Direct Record Electronic (“DRE”) System, as the term is defined in the Texas Election Code, shall be utilized in connection with the election. This system shall be utilized for all early voting as well as for all precinct voting conducted on Election Day. The City Secretary will appoint a programmer, who shall prepare a program for the automatic tabulating equipment. Ample voting equipment shall be provided for early voting and on Election Day.

SECTION 8. The City Secretary will appoint the Early Voting Ballot Board, a Presiding Judge of the Central Counting Station, a Tabulation Supervisor of the Central Counting Station, and a Central Counting Station Manager.

SECTION 9. The election will be held in accordance with the provisions of the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Humble and the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 10. Notice of the election, including a Spanish translation thereof, will be published at least once in a newspaper published in Humble on or after April 7, 2016 and on or before April 27, 2016, and will be posted on the bulletin board at City Hall on or before April 16, 2016.

SECTION 11. A writ of election as required by the Texas Election Code will be delivered on or before April 22, 2016 by the City Secretary to the presiding and alternate judges of the election.

SECTION 12. Testing of the automatic tabulation equipment will be performed and notice thereof will be given in accordance with Subchapter D of Chapter 127 of the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 13. If any portion of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 14. That this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Dear Mayor Aaron:

Throughout the years the leadership of the City of Humble has ensured that Humble is positioned well to serve its citizens. The Humble area sits at an important place – both geographically and in influence as we face continued growth opportunities in the surrounding region. The Lake Houston Area Chamber has benefited from our relationship with the City and has an interest to further that partnership through local and regional economic development.

While this area has grown significantly in population and in consumer related services, primary job growth has not kept up with the population growth in the area. We have a great story to tell but we have not had an organized economic development effort to market our region for primary jobs and capital investment. Because of the complexity of our jurisdictions, the lack of a unified political voice for the region and the need for growth management, the Lake Houston Area Chamber of Commerce formed a public-private partnership, the Lake Houston Area Economic Development Partnership (EDP), to provide a leadership role in our area's economic development.

To date, the EDP has established an organization structure, adopted a strategic plan, built an economic development website, developed demographics and a database of information on the area, began marketing the region, and submitting responses to RFIs to the Governor's Office of Economic Development and site selection consultants on economic development projects. To fund this effort, we established the program, *Priority One*, to raise funds from businesses and public entities that are exclusively used for economic development purposes and are not commingled with Chamber funds. As of today, we have received annual commitments of \$89,000. A list of contributors and the *Priority One* brochure is enclosed with this letter.

While we have made great strides in spite of our limited resources compared to our competing regions, we have a long way to go to be as competitive as we should be in the Houston region. An obvious missing link in the *Priority One* program is the participation of the City of Humble. If this program is going to be a true area-wide economic development effort, the City of Humble needs to be a major player not only to enhance its interests as the retail/service hub of the area, but also as a site for primary job producing entities. The City is dependent on people from

outside the city limits to sustain the retail, medical, and service businesses that compose the majority of the economic activity of Humble.

Many of the larger employers in the area are dependent on the continued growth of the area to sustain their business and without that growth in primary jobs, we do not attract as much capital investment in the area as other areas in the Houston region. Better jobs create more income. More income creates more discretionary spending.

Despite great transportation access, particularly to downtown Houston, a significant number of our residents commute to work daily from our area. The vision we are supporting is one where residents work, live, play, and shop here – as they do in other regions. A higher daytime population with good paying jobs in our area will help reduce retail and service leakage.

We can't expect someone to discover our area. We've got to tell our story and market the Lake Houston area, which includes the City of Humble. The Lake Houston Economic Development Partnership needs the City of Humble in order to be an effective advocate for this region. We have so many attributes, but the competition is keen and if we want to control our destiny, it is up to us to make it happen. We have to make economic development *Priority One*.

Therefore, the Lake Houston Economic Development Partnership formally requests the participation of the City of Humble in our efforts to build a better Lake Houston area and City of Humble. We respectfully request that the City of Humble become an investor of the Partnership at one of the levels indicated on the attached list of contributors.

We would welcome the opportunity to meet with you in person and discuss this request and answer any questions that you might have about Priority One.
